POINT DISTRIBUTION

Effective 2005-2006 Season

Approximately 75% of all points are distributed based on bowler's league participation and the remaining points are awarded based on tournament participation and achievement. This includes any youth program as long as bowler is a member in good standing, including adult/child leagues. (September - May).

Point Accumulation Year - June 1, 2005 through May 31, 2006.
